#### **ARRIVING ONSITE**

#### **V**ENUE

The event will take place on Market Square, ST16 2JP. At the bottom of this document is a map showing access to the site for unloading.

# **ADDITIONAL COVID-19 GUIDANCE**

To maintain the safety of the event site:

- face coverings are advised for your staff when serving customers.
- ensure that hand sanitiser is available on your stall.
- add signage to your stall to remind people to use hand sanitiser.
- limit the number of surfaces that people can touch and prevent people touching items on stalls, where possible.
- enhance cleaning regimes and increase hand washing or hand sanitiser stations, where possible.
- use card or contactless payments, where you have the capacity to do so.

#### SET UP

Set up is possible from 08:30.

Please stick to this time as closely as possible to avoid congestion.

### **GAZEBO RENTAL**

If you have booked a gazebo, you will be provided with a 2m x 2m gazebo which will be set up for you and weighted. Please check the final page of this document to make sure you know if you have booked a gazebo.

If you are providing your own gazebo you will need to bring your own gazebo weights.

You will need to bring your own table – these are not available to hire.

Your pitch will be clearly indicated on the site plan. When you arrive to set up, ask the Site Manager if you can't find your pitch. If you are setting up your own gazebo, please see the Site Manager before you erect it to check your space.

# **W**ASTE

You must take any waste you generate with you at the end of the event. Please ensure you recycle packaging and compost food waste, where possible.

# **COOKING OIL**

If you are cooking with oil at the event, then you must have a cover underneath your stall to prevent marking of the area.

# **W**ATER

There is no access to water at the event, so please bring what you will need with you.

# **Power**

There is no power available at this site, so please do not plug into anything onsite and ensure you have the capacity to operate without an electric power point.

### **EVENT TIMINGS**

The event will open to the public from 10:30 - 16:00.

# **PARKING**

The nearest car parks include Stafford Guildhall which has a height restriction of 1.98m, but you will need to follow the one-way system in the centre to access the site. There are other car parks in the vicinity, which include Broad Street and Stafford Sheridan Centre that reportedly have no height restrictions, but more limited spaces.

#### **BREAKDOWN**

**Breakdown will begin at 16:00**. All traders should have vacated the site by 17:30. Please check the breakdown timetable carefully, the times are staggered to avoid congestion.

## FIRE SAFETY

Anyone using gas or electrical equipment must have appropriate certification and fire extinguishers with them.


Please note, our Site Managers are only employed on the event day so please contact the office if you have any questions about the event before the day itself.

# **UNLOADING GUIDANCE**

Access to the Market square is via either Gaolgate Street from the roundabout or Market Street by turning left off Eastgate Street - the gap from Eastgate Street is approximately 8m (between the bus stop and the bollards on the photo) the gap next to Lloyds Bank is approximately 4m wide at the most – there is a movable bollard.

To exit you can just drive straight down Greengate Street to the end and either go right at the mini roundabout which brings you out on to Tenterbanks or straight on which will bring you out on to the A518.
