Trader's Information Pack - 2020

The Derby Vegan Market is a free one-day outdoor event filled with up to 40 stalls selling a huge variety of vegan food, clothes, drinks and cosmetics alongside charity and information stalls. The two events in 2019 were both very well attended. At each event in 2020 we expect to attract an audience of up to 1200 directly in addition to the high footfall the city centre experiences on any given weekend.

Venue

The market will be held on the Derby Market Place (the large area outside the Assembly Rooms, DE1 3AH). This site is located right in the centre of the city which gets busy extremely at weekends.

Dates & Timings

The market will run from 10:30 – 16:00 on Saturday 21st March, Sunday 21st June and Saturday 19th September.

Booking Options

All pitches are 2m x 2m or 3m x 3m (if own gazebo is provided). Traders may provide their own gazebos, however we do have gazebos and tables for hire. Traders will need to provide their own tablecloths.

- Catering stall £179 (3m x 6m space - if you intend to serve hot food and cook on site)
- 2m x 2m Gazebo hire £5
- 5ft Table hire £5

Power

Power is available for £20. Power outlets are limited so please book early.

Gas

Gas is permitted on site. You must provide proof of certification.

Parking

The nearest carpark is the Assembly Rooms Carpark, Full St, Derby DE1 3AF.

Stall Criteria

- All stalls are subject to organiser approval.
- Acceptance, products and services must fulfil our requirements of being healthy, sustainable and ethical.
- Products and services sold or promoted must be suitable for vegans.
- Non-vegan businesses are welcome provided they only sell and promote vegan products and services on the day.
- Products must not have been tested on animals.
- No plastic bags are to be given out. Eco, hessian or paper bags are suggested as alternatives.
