Trader's Information Pack - 2020

The St Albans Vegan Market is a one-day outdoor event filled with 50 stalls selling a huge variety of vegan food, clothes, drinks and cosmetics alongside charity and information stalls. The three events in 2019 were huge successes and very popular with the local community. At each event in 2020 we expect to attract an audience of up to 1200 directly in addition to the high footfall the city centre experiences on any given Sunday.

Venue

The market will be held on St Peters Street (the large area outside the St Albans Museum and Gallery, AL1 3DH). This site is located right in the centre of the city which gets busy extremely on Sundays.

Dates & Timings

The market will run from 10:30 – 16:00 on Sunday 2nd February, Sunday 5th April, Sunday 5th July and Sunday 4th October.

Booking Options

All trader spaces are 10ft x 6ft market stalls and will include a table top (see photos at the bottom of this document). Traders will need to provide their own tablecloths and chairs.

- Standard stall £89
- Catering stall £189 (required if serving hot food and/or cooking on site)

Power

Power is available for £20. Power outlets are limited so please book early.

Gas

Gas is permitted on site. You must provide proof of certification.

Parking

The nearest carpark is the Christopher Place Car Park, 3 Upper Dagnall St, St Albans AL3 5EA which is £1 parking all day on a Sunday.

Stall Criteria

- All stalls are subject to organiser approval.
- Acceptance, products and services must fulfil our requirements of being healthy, sustainable and ethical.
- Products and services sold or promoted must be suitable for vegans.
- Non-vegan businesses are welcome provided they only sell and promote vegan products and services on the day.
- Products must not have been tested on animals.
- No plastic bags are to be given out. Eco, hessian or paper bags are suggested as alternatives.
