Your event is almost here and we're very excited to have you joining us for what should be a fantastic day for you and your business. The following information will give you an idea of what to expect from the event, what we will expect from you as a stall holder and how to maximise the return on your attendance.

ARRIVING ONSITE

Our Site Manager will be on-the-ground when you arrive, in a high-vis, and can direct you to your allocated pitch.

Every event is slightly different, so make sure you know what time you are scheduled to arrive, what equipment you'll need to bring, where the pitch you have been allocated is positioned, how to get to the site, and where to park. You can find all of that information as follows:

VENUE

The event will take place on the High Street, WR1 3LD, and Cathedral Square, WR1 2BY. At the bottom of this document is a map showing access to the site for unloading.

ADDITIONAL COVID-19 GUIDANCE

To maintain the safety of the event site:

- face coverings are advised for your staff when serving customers.
- ensure that hand sanitiser is available on your stall.
- add signage to your stall to remind people to use hand sanitiser.
- limit the number of surfaces that people can touch and prevent people touching items on stalls, where possible.
- enhance cleaning regimes and increase hand washing or hand sanitiser stations, where possible.
- use card or contactless payments, where you have the capacity to do so.

SET UP

Set up is possible from 08:00. All vehicles must be off the site by 09:30.

A site plan and timetable will be available at the following link a few days before the event so you will know which pitch you have been allocated and when you are expected to arrive: https://www.veganmarkets.co.uk/setup-information

Please stick to this time as closely as possible to avoid congestion.

GAZEBO RENTAL

If you have booked a gazebo, you will be provided with a 2m x 2m gazebo which will be set up for you and weighted. Please check the final page of this document to make sure you know if you have booked a gazebo.

If you are providing your own gazebo you will need to bring your own gazebo weights.

You will need to bring your own table – these are not available to hire.

Your pitch will be clearly indicated on the site plan. When you arrive to set up, ask the Site Manager if you can't find your pitch. If you are setting up your own gazebo, please see the Site Manager before you erect it to check your space.

WASTE

You must take any waste you generate with you at the end of the event. Please ensure you recycle packaging and compost food waste, where possible.

COOKING OIL

If you are cooking with oil at the event, then you must have a cover underneath your stall to prevent marking of the stone.

WATER

There is no access to water at the event, so please bring what you will need with you.

Power

There are 16A and 32A sockets available on the site to those that have paid for it in advance - please make sure that you bring the correct adapters and long extension leads with you.

EVENT TIMINGS

The event will open to the public from 11:00 - 18:00.

PARKING

Copenhagen Street Car Park is one of the closest carparks (4 minute walk) with a 1.98m height restriction and a £10 charge for up to 24 hours. Cornmarket Carpark (7 minute walk) has no height restriction and a charge of £10 for up to 24 hours. The Cattle Market Car Park (9 minute walk) has a height restriction of 2.05m and a charge of £6 for up to 24 hours.

BREAKDOWN

Breakdown will begin at 18:00. All traders should have vacated the site by 19:30. Please check the breakdown timetable carefully, the times are staggered to avoid congestion.

FIRE SAFETY

Anyone using gas or electrical equipment must have appropriate certification and fire extinguishers with them.

CONTACT

Please note, our Site Managers are only employed on the event day so please contact the office if you have any questions about the event before the day itself.

UNLOADING GUIDANCE


Follow directions to: **Gold Stitch, 4 Charles St, Worcester, WR1 2AQ** and then drive up Pump Street and onto the High Street as shown in the images below.

Depending on where your pitch is, you will either need to turn left and head for Cathedral Square or right to continue up the High Street.

Your allocated pitch will be shown on the site plan which will be uploaded to https://www.veganmarkets.co.uk/setup-information around 3 days before the event. You can unload next to your pitch but please do not block the High Street, other vehicles will need access throughout the morning.

Once unloaded, drive North up the High Street to exit onto the A38. **Vehicles are not permitted on the High Street or Cathedral Square between 10:00 and 18:00.**
