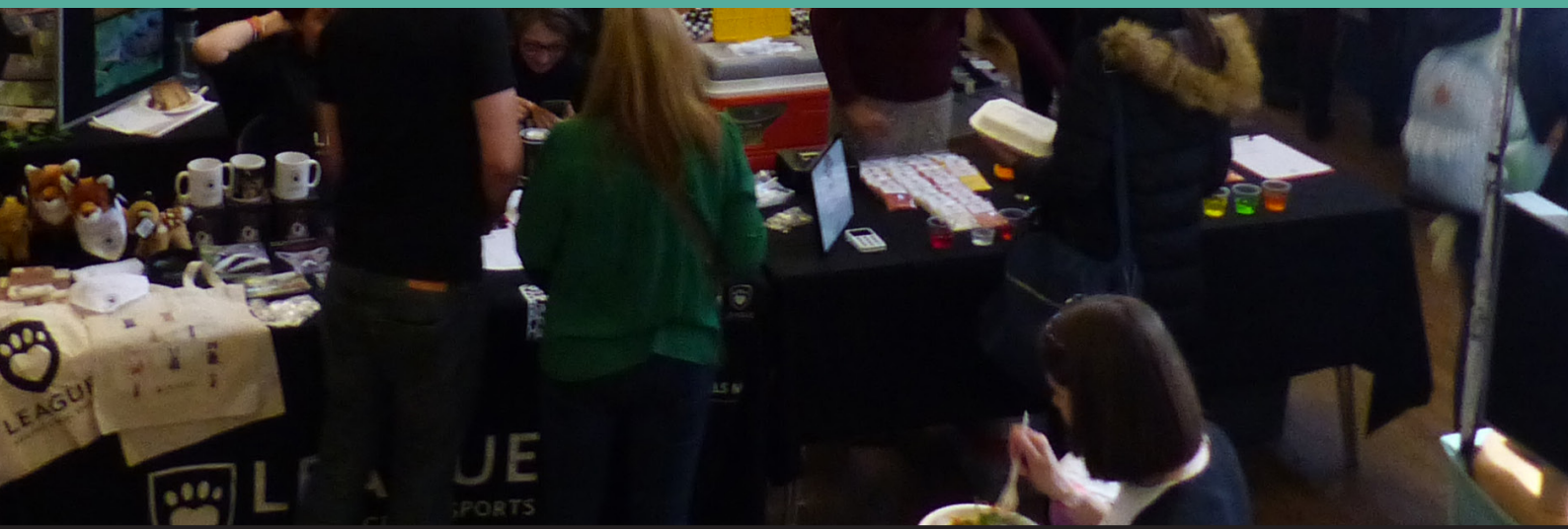

The Oxford Vegan Market is a one day event filled with over 50 stalls selling a huge variety of vegan food, clothes, drinks and cosmetics alongside charity and information stalls. The events in 2018 and 2019 have been very popular with a combined attendance of over 6000 visitors across the five events. We expect to attract up to 1300 visitors at the event in January 2020.

Venue

The market will be held in the Town Hall (St Aldate's Street, OX1 1BD). This venue is ideally located right in the centre of the town, next to the high street which gets extremely busy at the weekend.

Dates & Timings

The market will be open to the public from 10:30 – 16:00 on Saturday 25th January 2020.

Booking Options

All trader spaces come with chairs and a trestle table but traders will need to provide their own table cloths.

- Standard stall £89 (1 6ft trestle table)
- Corner stall £129 (2 6ft trestle tables arranged in an L-shape)

Power

Power is available for £20. Power outlets are limited so please book early.

Gas

Gas is NOT permitted on site.

Stall Criteria

All stalls are subject to organiser approval. Acceptance, products and services must fulfil our requirements of being healthy, sustainable and ethical.

Products and services sold or promoted must be suitable for vegans.

Non-vegan businesses are welcome provided they only sell and promote vegan products and services on the day.

Products must not have been tested on animals.

No plastic bags are to be given out. Eco, hessian or paper bags are suggested as alternatives.
