Trader's Information Pack - 2020

The Northampton Vegan Market is a free one day outdoor event filled with up to 40 stalls selling a huge variety of vegan food, clothes, drinks and cosmetics alongside charity and information stalls. At each event in 2020 we expect to attract an audience of up to 1200 directly in addition to the high footfall the town centre experiences on any given Sunday.

Venue

The event will be held on the Market Square, NN1 2DL. This site is located right in the centre of the town which experiences a high footfall on weekends.

Dates & Timings

The event will run from 10:30 – 16:00 on Sunday 23rd February, Sunday 13th September and Sunday 29th November.

Booking Options

All trader spaces are 3m x 3m semi-permanent gazebos and will include a slated table top. Traders will need to provide their own tablecloths and chairs

- Standard stall £69
- Catering stall £179 - double space (required if serving or cooking hot food on site)

Power

Power is available for £20. Power outlets are limited so please book early.

Gas

Gas is permitted on site. You must provide proof of certification.

Parking

The nearest carpark is the Multi Storey Car Park, Grosvenor Centre, Union Street, Northampton, NN1 2BS which offers very affordable parking on a Sunday.

Stall Criteria

- All stalls are subject to organiser approval.
- Acceptance, products and services must fulfil our requirements of being healthy, sustainable and ethical.
- Products and services sold or promoted must be suitable for vegans.
- Non-vegan businesses are welcome provided they only sell and promote vegan products and services on the day.
- Products must not have been tested on animals.
- No plastic bags are to be given out. Eco, hessian or paper bags are suggested as alternatives.
